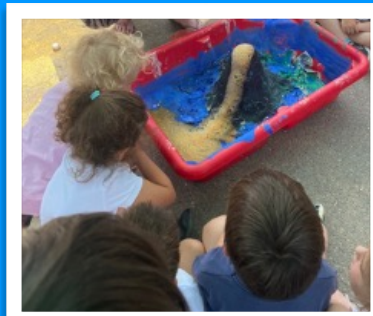

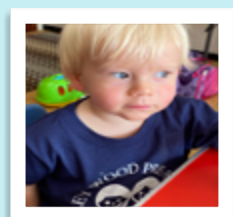

Hydration Station

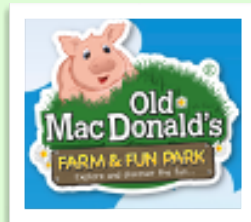
Children enjoying fruit water infusions to keep cool
